SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT REPORT

Deputy Benkelmann gave the crime stats for December 2023. For the Township, the Deputies took 135 offense reports (23 were violent crimes, 17 were property, 11 personal, 9 drug/alcohol related, 72 information reports, and 3 juvenile related). This was a 10.9% increase from last month. The highest crime type was theft, totaling 12.

The Batavia Township Deputies took 170 offense reports, 129 incident reports, 71 assists, 27 adult arrests, 4 juvenile arrests and 159 business checks. We took 93% of the incident reports total and 79% of the offense reports. We recovered \$22,000 in property which included multiple stolen vehicles and miscellaneous items. We patrolled 340 neighborhoods this month. There were two overdoses. There were two burglaries in December. There was one breaking and entering in December.

The Batavia Township Trustees and Fiscal Officer presented a service recognition award to Deputy Travis Blanton for his service to the Township.

Introduced and welcomed to the Township was Deputy Jester.

PLANNING AND ZONING DIRECTOR/INSPECTOR REPORT

Taylor Corbett, Planning and Zoning Director, gave the December 2023 report.

We completed the Estrella subdivision, multifamily/patio home section.

The total year-to-date is 103 single-family homes with 159 attached.

SERVICE DIRECTOR REPORT

Cody Smith, Service Director, gave the December report for maintenance activities.

The Department completed the berm on Greenbriar Road, which made it about a 6-foot wider, flat area. We also repaired a sinkhole on Greenbriar.

We finished installing the Corporation signs, totaling 22 installed. There are 3 extra posts and 2 spare signs.

Footers were poured at the cemetery. The fence at Odd Fellows was installed/completed.

We repaired a berm on Elmwood Road.

We completed trimming/ditching behind the old Homeless Shelter.

We are repairing two areas on Snider Road.

TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR REPORT

Karen Swartz, Township Administrator, gave the December report.

The stonework, gutters, etc., on the building have been completed.

We received the Purina Grant for the dog park. There was discussion about the uses of the grant.

Karen is working on the water line and easement. She has the quotes and is awaiting the final construction plans.

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The filed annexation on behalf of property owners was denied by the Commissioners. An appeal has not been filed.

Karen is working with OTA on legislation.

Karen completed the BWC audit for 2022 and there were no violations. Jennifer was commended for a job well done.

The County Trustee Meeting is being held this month. Karen is finalizing a speaker.

Karen applied for an OTA scholarship.

Karen updated the Board on the new cemetery software. Cody worked on updating our maps for two cemeteries for Lucy Run and Olive Branch, for the software. We had a request for a cremation burial in Odd Fellows this week, the first since 2008.

Duke will send Karen a list of all the lights that are no longer being used so they can be turned off. This is mainly in the former Village of Amelia area.

The drainage around the former Homeless Shelter Building is a problem. Cody will work on ditching and soil build-up around the building and Duke is going to come back to complete some drainage improvements.

Karen spoke about the Park Adoption Memorial program, adopt-a-bench, tree planting, costs, etc.

The Clark Home that displayed all the Christmas lights shut down on Christmas Day due to the chaos of all the traffic. Cody and Karen will meet with Mr. Clark tomorrow to work on ideas for next year's display. Mr. Clark owns Clark Landscaping in Owensville.

Karen has been attending the Kiwanis meetings and numerous HOA meetings throughout the year. Karen will send the dates to the Trustees.

Karen will research more grant opportunities.

We are looking for a Salute To Leaders nomination.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Mr. Sauls and Mr. Perry gave an update for Central Joint Fire & EMS District. The total runs last month was 313. There was a special meeting to approve next year's appropriations. The new District Chief started, Matt Brown. We have a new firefighter. We will get a new Board member.

Mr. Parsons gave the update for Batavia Union Cemetery. For the year, we had 44 burials, 16 were cremations. The cremations are down. For the finances, we have everything budgeted. We have two quotes for paving some of the main roads in Batavia Union Cemetery.

We are currently at 40 internments at Union Cemetery, 15 are cremations. There are 5 cremations this week. There is an issue with some lot ownerships in the cemetery.
